The regular meeting of the Austinburg Township Board of Trustees opened at 7:30 pm. Residents in attendance included Mike Kovacic, Sarah Frank, Ginny Seifert, Cliff Skaggs and John Beninato.

The meeting opened with bid packages being opened for the Dadeyville Road and alternate Township Hall parking lot paving. There were four bids received. Res. 80-20 John moved to accept Koski bid for paving Dadeyville Road for \$150,931.00 pending verification from the Prosecutor and the Engineers Office, Jerry seconded. The roll; Burke, aye. Dutton, aye. Kusar, aye. The Trustees voted only on the base bid for Dadeyville Road. The alternate bid for the Township Townhall was not accepted.

Bills paid were \$30,982.49 and Receipts were \$1,173.75.


