Commission discussed previous resolutions; Sarah will prepare a document for the trustees to sign and for Shara to file at the county recorder's office.

Commission discussed the difficulty of finding the township's website; Sarah will follow up to find out what can be done to make it more accessible by the public.

Commission reviewed and edited drafts to zoning text. Shara questioned the use of the zoning text of Vandalia, Ohio, as a model for Austinburg; Jackie clarified it was the good language and not necessarily all the details that are of potential help. Members reviewed screening vs. buffer zone, the current definition of buffer area, and a potential hedge definition. Ted Seifert suggested referencing green space in Article 8 and the opaque fence next to the school.

Jackie updated Commission on All In Ashtabula County, stating that it will probably be approved at the end of this month. Jackie recommended, once it is approved, that the Commission look at the Austinburg sections and the map at allinashtabulacounty.org

Shara clarified all boards are directed by the State to now meet in person for discussing and voting on public business.
